ABOUT CTC FOUNDATION

CTC Foundation College offers a one year, full time pre-vocational course in Musical Theatre for ages 16 – 24 years. Located in Needham Market, just off the A14, CTC Studios boasts **state of the art, purpose built studios** with fantastic public transport links and ample free parking on site.

We offer affordable, innovative, **triple threat musical theatre tuition** for those wishing to take their training to the next level and/or prepare for drama school auditions. As a registered LAMDA centre, the CTC offers students **qualifications in Acting, Musical Theatre and Shakespeare** with an allocation of up to **126 UCAS points**.

The CTC recognises and celebrates individuality. Students are encouraged to make choices about their own training within our pathway system which allows students to specialise in acting, singing or dance depending on their individual strengths and progression throughout the course. Our focus is YOU!

At the start of the course all students will embark upon six weeks intense training with equal weighting across all three disciplines; acting, singing and dance.


* with specialist workshops and tutorials in Acro, Pilates & Yoga, Mindfulness & Wellbeing, Tap, Acting for Camera, Voiceovers, Shakespeare and Contextual studies Following assessments at half term, students will then choose their pathway for the next six weeks all aimed to provide a **bespoke**, **focussed and challenging training programme** for each individual student. Student Pathways are then reviewed every half-term until Easter before reverting back to an equal weighting for the end of year showcase rehearsals.

The CTC faculty consists of **fully qualified, professional and experienced teachers** all of whom specialise in their chosen field and offer aspirational and technical tuition across all three disciplines. With **mock auditions** and regular visits from **guest tutors** (current working professionals) throughout the course, students will gain a continual and invaluable insight into the Performing Arts industry.

- Studio 2: Acting Studio equipped with digital piano, Sonos Play 1 speakers and partition to separate into two smaller studios.
- ☆ Studio 3: Music Room & Library equipped with a digital piano, Sonos Play 1 speakers, music scores and scripts.
- ☆ Studio 4: Dance Studio equipped with WOODLAND™ SPRUNG DANCE FLOOR, full length mirrors, portable ballet barres, digital piano and Sonos Play 1 surround sound system.
- ☆ Fully equipped gym: adjacent to studios. Open 7 days a week, equipped with Life Fitness top of the range equipment including treadmills, cross trainers, cycles, steppers, rowers, vibro stations and free weights.
- Changing facilities: equipped with benches, mirrors, student kitchenette, sofa chill out area and toilets.
- Scenic workshop: Prop and set store for studio use and hire.
- ☆ CTC Wardrobe: Costume store for studio use and hire.

CTC Studios has ample free parking available directly outside the studios as well as excellent public transport links close by.



ABOUT THE AUDITION

Auditions candidates are asked to prepare the following:

- A monologue (contemporary or classical)
- A musical theatre song (to be accompanied by piano)
- Audition pieces should be no longer than 2 minutes each.

Audition candidates will also take part in a Jazz class which will include a warm up, technical exercises and a short musical theatre dance routine.

All candidates will be given a tour of the studios and the audition process will conclude with a short interview with the Principal.

COURSE FEES

Course fees: £6,995

5% discount when paid in full prior to the start of the course.

Additional payment and part-funding options will be considered during the audition process based on individual circumstances.

NEEDHAM MARKET

Needham Market is a quaint town set in the heart of Gipping Valley amidst the beautiful Suffolk countryside. Local amenities including supermarkets, cafés and restaurants are within walking distance from the studios along the town's historical high street. Needham Lake is a popular picturesque attraction for walks and picnics and is situated just behind the Studios; ideal for some fresh countryside air during the lunch break or at the end of the day. Student accommodation is also available within the town and the surrounding areas for those wishing to live nearby.

With excellent public transport links, Needham Market sits on the Great Eastern Mainline with hourly trains from all major towns including **Ipswich** (10 minutes), **Bury St. Edmunds** (25 minutes), **Norwich** (45 minutes) and **Colchester** (45 minutes). The studios are a short 10 minute walk from the train station.

CTC Studios are located 2 minutes from the A14, perfectly situated for access from all parts of the country via the A12, A120, A140, A134, M11 and M25.
